In the name of god amen I Alexander Simmons of the County of Southampton being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be almighty god for the same do make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (Wit) First I give and bequeath unto my Cousin Ann Williams, (of Nicholas) my horse bridle and saddle and the sum of one hundred dollars I do also give and bequeath unto my sister Nancy Simmons, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, I do also give and bequeath unto my Brother George Simmons, my Trunk wearing apparel of all kinds whatsoever and the sum of Ten dollars I do also give and bequeath unto my sister Charlotte Wicks and my Brother Thomas Simmons, and Henry Simmons, this sum of thirty three pounds ten Shillings and seven pence apiece. I do also give and bequeath unto John Williams (of Nicholas) one half of my bacon I do also give and bequeath unto the above named Ann Williams, and sister Nancy Simmons, the other half, I do also give and bequeath unto Nicholas Williams, (of Nicholas) my Spurs, I do also give and bequeath unto the said John Williams, all my tools whatsoever, and lastly, as to all the rest residue and remainder of my real and personal estate, goods, and Chattles, of what kind and nature soever, I give and bequeath the same to the above named John Williams, whom I hereby appoint sole executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 16th day of April in the year of our lords 1810.
