Know all men by these presents that I Arthur Foster of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia being law mind weak but of sound and disposing mind and memory and believing that it is appointed once for all given in, see, do make and mean the my last will and Testament in manner and form following, to wit,

1st I give unto my loving wife Martha Foster during her natural life, all my lands lying and being in the county of Southampton together with my two title and their appurtenances, including all my hatched vessels (except those containing board) of every denomination, also my apple mill and its appurtenances, and at her death I give and bequeath the same to my son Nathaniel Foster to have and his heirs forever

2nd I give to my loving wife Martha Foster during her natural life, the following negroes, to wit Jacobson Isaac, Ben, Bob, Chelley and child youngest child named child child, Fanny also as usual

3rd I give to my loving wife Martha Foster during her natural life, all my household & kitchen furniture together with all the utensils and implements of farming, also dining furniture also all the provisions of every kind as laid in for the family consumption, also twenty head of cattle her choice, also thirty head of hogs her choice and all my stock of sheep also four head of horses her choice also my riding chain After the death of my wife I sever that her legacy contained in the second & third stands sold and the money arising from such sale to be equally divided as hereinafter mentioned

4th I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Foster my negro man Fanny to him and his heirs forever

5th I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Haze my negro man Lewis to her and her heirs forever

6th I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Vaughan my negro man Moses to her and her heirs forever

7th I give and bequeath to my grandson James Foster my two negro boys Amosy Abraham and little Jacob to him and his heirs forever

8th I give and bequeath to my grandson William Foster all my lands lying and being in the county of Suffolk to him and his heirs forever

9th I give and bequeath to my grand children namely Lucy Arthur, Rebecca and Arthur Foster heirs of Arthur Foster each one hundred dollars each to them and their heirs forever to be paid to them whenever they come of age or marry, thirds of which money I leave to my two as compensation for selling my estate

10th I give and bequeath to John Vaughan and James M. Vaughan children of Ind^d Vaughan and Arthur his wife one hundred dollars each to them and their heirs forever to be paid to them by my two as they come of age or marry thirds of which I leave to my two
