I Hannah Lusk of Southampton county in Virginia as heretofore make my last will and testament in manner and form following that unto say first I give to my son Gilbert Lusk one horse colt and also one cow and pigs second I give to my son Washington Lusk the colt the mare is worth £20 with feed with feed two shillings third I give to my daughter Rhoda Lusk the old mare after she has foaled also one cow and colf also two feather beds fourth I give unto my two daughters Anne Powell and Febbie West one dollar each out of the effects to be raised fifth I give my will and devise that after the above legacies and paces of the remainder of the remainder of my estate may be divided equally between any three children Gilbert Washington and Rhoda this my will and devise that none of my estate may be sold except to pay my just debts or my funeral charge it is my will that Benjamin Whitfield and Anna Barnes and Matthew Barnes my servant shall have equally Between them three other names Children after the legal birth of and Benjamin Whitfield to take in proportion the two boys and their part of the property as follows till they come to age to receive it as the girl is of age she may take her part in proportion as the dividends as during my life has been used this tenth day of August hundred and seven

Nicholas Schell of the county of Southampton and late of the county of Long Island state of Virginia (proposing) as much memory of mind understandeing as can be done do make and direct that this shall be his last will and testament in manner and form following to wit

I do hereby appropriate all my estate in Bond as a fund for the discharge of all my debts I do hereby give unto my beloved wife Betsy all the property that came to her and was left to her by her deceased husband Jasimus Edmunds of whos love owing to her and her heirs forever and I do further give unto my beloved wife Betsy a half share of my estate in Long Island after my just debts being paid during her nativie life and after her death I do give and give the same unto my beloved wife Mary Ann Schell to her and her heirs forever it is my will and desire that my estate may be appraised I do hereby appoint my loving wife Betsy and my brother James Schell my trustees and executors of the my last will and testament and if any difficulties should arise respecting this my last will and testament as to the meaning and intent of the same it is my wish and desire that it may be referred to those respectable men whose decision shall be valid as if it had been made by the Supreme court of the United States - As this my last will and testament is witnessed with my own hand and subscribed before me at the time and place by me aforesaid to be upon
