 first I desire that all my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged.
 Then I give and bequeath to my son Jonathan Bryant the lands and planta-
 tion whereon I now live and one young mare the best and fittest one
 cow and calf one hog one chest one pewter dish one pewter basin and half doz
 spoons these are given to him and his heirs forever.

Then I give to my son Joshua Bryant and fifteen pounds cash to him and his heirs for
 them I give my daughter Mary Bryant one bed and furniture one chest.

It is my will and desire that my executor after my death should equally
 divide the balance of if any remaining five children, Bailey Brittain Joshua
 Jonathan and Mary, I likewise devise and appoint my son Britain
 Bryant whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament given
 under my hands this 10th day of October 1810.
