In the name of God amen this 30th day of May one thousand eight hundred and eleven I Elizabeth Schell of the county of Northampton being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly goods and estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I do hereby make this my last will and testament revoking all other heretofore made in manner and form following —

First I desire to give my soul to God who gave it me and my body to be decently buried, and as touching my worldly estate I give I give them in manner and form following —

Item 1st I give unto my brothers and sisters Bullock Saunders Samuel Saunders Polly Gholson Patsy Saunders and the children of my sister Nancy Pope and to my half brother Wilkins Casper all my estate to wit. The negroes left me by my husband Samuel Edmunds and my said her children with all the money left me by him this said Samuel Edmunds ^{in the absence of} my executor of his estate together with all the estate left me in his will including a legacy left me by my first husband Samuel Edmunds to his said Sally Edmunds which became laps by the death of said Sally Edmunds also all the estate left me by my late husband Nicholas Schell with all the estate I may in part of of in the way and manner hereafter mentioned — — — — —

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my brother Bullock Saunders one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to him and his heirs forever —

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my brother Samuel Saunders one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to him and his heirs forever —

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my sister Polly Gholson one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to her and her heirs forever —

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my sister Patsy Saunders one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to her and her heirs forever —

Item 6th I give and bequeath unto the children of my sister Nancy Pope one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item the use of the said part to be for the benefit of my said sister Nancy Pope during her lifetime and to be under the management and care of my brother
