bless me with I do hereby make this my last will and testament revoking
all others heretofore made in manner and form following

First I give to god who gave it me according to his will to be decently buried and to touching my worldly estate I pray
I give them in manner and form following

Item¹ I give unto my brothers and sisters Hubbard Saunders Turner
Saunders Polley Johnson Saunders and the children of my
sister Nancy Bap and to my half brother Willkins Harper all my
estate to wit The negro left me by my husband Samuel Edmunds and
my self and her children with all the money left me by him the said
Samuel Edmunds now the executor of his estate together with all the
estate left me in his will including a legacy left me by my first hus-
band Samuel Edmunds to his slave Sally Edmunds which became
lapse by the death of said Sally Edmunds also all the estate left me by
my late husband Nicholas Debelle with all the estate I may see fit to
of in the way and manner hereafter mentioned

Item² I give and bequeath unto my brother Hubbard Saunders one equal
share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to him and his
heirs forever

Item³ I give and bequeath unto my sister Polley Johnson one equal
share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to her and her
heirs forever

Item⁴ I give and bequeath unto my sister Nancy Bap one equal
share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item to her and her
heirs forever

Item⁵ I give and bequeath unto the children of my sister Nancy Bap
one equal share of all my estate as above mentioned in the 1st item
the use of the said part to be for the benefit of my sister Nancy Bap during
her lifetime and to be under the management and care of my brother
