of July 1811 This last will and testament of Elizabeth

And on the motion of said William Gholson one of the executors therein
named (being qualified for the other to qualify) who swore and ac-

In the name of God I James Jones of Southampton county being weak
in body but of sound disposing mind and memory do make this my last will
and testament in manner and form following. My

Know I give and bequeath unto my three sons David Sumners and Joseph Jones
one hundred and fifty acres of land lying on the north side of my plantation
to be equally divided between them provided they pay to their father James and Nancy
Jones the sum of fifty dollars to each son, which will be forty five pounds to them.
And their heirs forever any sum is that if either of those sons should
blateth to sell his lands they would give their brother the first offer —
I leave the use of two cows and calves and their milk and two ewes
and lambs two mus and pigs one feather bed and furniture as I direct
you chest to my loving wife during her natural life. I also leave all the use
of all the remainder part of my estate lands which is not already disposed of to my
loving wife for single life and also all former provisions so my two
daughters their single life and at the death of my wife my or man-
— wife I give the lands and I leave her the use of to my son Samuel
to have and to his heirs also my brandy still provided said son
to pay to his sister the sum of fifty dollars to be divided between them
be it understood by the entire intent and meaning of this will
that if any amission had taken place on my wife and
