

There is that if either of my said children should die without lawful issue
that then all of their property of what kind or quality now is shall then
return to his or her surviving brother and sister
And lastly my will and desire is that after paying all my just debts that
all the remainder part of my estate be equally divided between all
my children except Betsy who is to be cut that the value of a feather
bed which he now has in possession. — But if any of my children should
be dissatisfied with their property or legacy left them and should cause any
obstruction or malicious suits to be brought in that case together all be dis-
inherited —

And lastly I do nominate and appoint my friends William Warrin and
my son Betsy Jones my whole and sole executors to this my last will and
testament making and annulling all other wills and testaments this
and no other to be my last will and testament. — In witness whereof
I have hereunto signing sealed and affixed my seal this third day of
July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven
signed sealed and
relieved in the presence of

of James Jones Esq. as in this day presented in court by
James Briggs William Warrin and Betsy Jones the executors therein
named proved by the oaths of William Warrin and Samuel Barnett two
of the High Court of Chancery and ordered to be recorded and in the presence of
said William Warrin and Betsy Jones the executors therein named and
made with according to law ^{and the} ~~testament~~ granted them for obtaining a probate
of the same on their giving bond and security whereupon to —

I Thomas Dimonds of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia being
with and law full of sound and disposing mind and memory and believing
that it is appointed once for all men to die to make and ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following. I wit-

I Thomas I give and bequeath unto Rebecca F. Holladay daughter of Thos
Holladay and Mary his wife one negro woman named Mary and
her child Doreas also four hundred pounds to her and her heirs forever —

And I give and bequeath to Thos & Holladay son of Thomas Holladay and Mary
his wife one negro woman named Eliza also four hundred pounds to her
and her heirs forever —

And I give and bequeath to Samuel & Holladay son of Thos Holladay
and Mary his wife one negro woman named Eliza also four hundred pounds
to him and his heirs forever — my will and desire is that the said legacies
be left for the term of 3 years to James Mallock Esq. to be by him administered
by the above legacies according to their several necessities and
