Lastly My will and desire is that the above mentioned estate should
be red for the best price for twelve months credit and the money
arising therefrom to be left in the hands of my executor and deli-
vered to the said Elizabeth as she requires. I do hereby constitute and
appoint my friend Bannicle Barrett executor of this my last will and
testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
