Will

Item agreeable to the fourth steam of my deceased husband Benwell Williams now well known that is a never noted mine to dispose of all the property sent me in such proportions as I may think proper between my two daughters Melvuth Boykin and Nancy Hughes and by virtue of the authority above alluded to do dispose of all the property that or given me by my deceased husband will in the following proportions to wit —

First I give to my daughter Melvuth Boykin one hundred and fifty dollars in here or as her proportion of my deceased husband Benwell Williams estate first or given me with every other species of property heretofore bequeathed to her when made his form —

Second I give to my daughter Nancy Hughes Negro Aaron before of her two children Lily and Emma to be forever at her my said daughter own disposal also every slave and all other property that was sent or given me by my said husband Benwell Williams as his proportion of said estate.

Thirdly I give to my grandson William Hughes one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever —

Fourthly I give to my grandson John Hughes one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever —

Fifthly I give to my grandson Richard Hughes one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever —

Sixthly I give to my grandson Charles F Hughes one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever —

Seventhly I give to my grandson Charles B Hughes one hundred pounds to him and his heirs forever —

Eighthly I bestow the use of my plantation on sea side to my daughter Melvuth Boykin during her natural life or widowhood, and as her my said daughter in marriage or death I give the said plantation to my grandson William Boykin to him and his heirs forever.

Ninthly I give the balance of my estate of what nature or kind soever to my daughter Nancy Hughes to him and his heirs forever —
