At a court held for the county of Southampton the day of Feb. 1811 This account current of the estate of Nathl. Chapman died was this day reported at council and approved of by the court and ordered to be recorded.

I am the owner of the estate of Henry Teller of the county of Brunswick being in perfect health and mind and being desirous to secure the same to my wife and children I have appointed for all men to die I do make this my last will and testament in the following manner to wit

First my will and desire is that my representatives hereafter mentioned or named shall as soon as convenient after my death shall so much of my personal estate that can be best spared as shall be sufficient for the payment of all my just debts. 2nd My will is that I hereby nominate and appoint Mr. John Turner Wellesbourne and Robert Munnell of Hampton to settle after my death all disputes that may happen or take place between any of my children touching or concerning any part of my estate and every settlement made by them or a word of theirs be as bind and against all my any of my children as if it had or have been settled or determined in a court of record in the Commonwealth of Virginia and my will is further that neither of my children shall not one of them institute a suit against the other for any part or parts of my estate in any court of record, if they or my will is that they shall be ever rebound from having any right title to any part of the property that I shall hereafter mention in my will &c.

and will and desire is that is their living wife Christiana Teller and my children shall divide the same in the same manner as I have directed in my will
