

if any disputes should take place between her or them concerning my estate, my will is that if either the above persons shall have appointed themselves or someone my executor, that someone shall be filled up from time to time by the county court of Greenville and the person or persons so appointed by them shall have the power and authority as the persons first appointed by me —

Thirty. I send to my loving wife Christiana Tellow during her natural life or widowhood the following negroes, namely, Paymore, James, Frank, Henry, Mary, Dingle and Louisa, my stock of all kinds and all my household and kitchen furniture except what I shall hereafter dispose of to my children — And also I shall send my loving wife Ch. Tellow the use of all my lands during her natural life or widowhood or when my son Edmund Tellow shall arrive at the age of twenty one which shall first happen — then he shall be entitled to two thirds of the lands and the other third at her death. my will is that if my wife does marry she shall have the use during her life of all the above named negroes except Frank and also one third of my stock and household furniture — and my will is that the remaining two thirds of my stock and household furniture shall be equally divided between three of my children, namely, Edmund Tellow, Nicotia Tellow and Fannetta Tellow to them and their heirs forever —

Forty. I then give to my two daughters Nicotia Tellow and Fannetta Tellow the following negroes to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever — but in case they should die or either of them the said negroes should be divided between Edmund Tellow the survivor of me he and I give the following negroes and increase, namely, Silvia, Sally, Sidney, Henry, Mary, Henry, Isabella, Felix, Agrippa, Frank, & a bed and furniture — each of them and their cars and calf each — and twenty pounds to each for to my share —

Then I give to my son Edmund Tellow at the death of my wife Christiana Tellow all the lands that I am proprietor of or shall be at my death in North Carolina my will and desire is that if my son Edmund Tellow die without lawful issue shall then all my lands above mentioned shall go to my son Edmund Tellow if he is alive, if not to my two daughters Nicotia Tellow & Fannetta Tellow and their heirs forever and further give to my son Edmund Tellow, Matthew, Bob, Peter and James one bed and furniture or horse worth one hundred and twenty dollars, and all the cattle that shall increase from a cow give him and ~~of the~~ of Floss and after the death of my wife Christiana Tellow the following negroes to wit Paymore, James, Henry, Mary, Dingle and their increase
