

I then, I give and bequeath unto my son, Benjamin Cooper after marriage or death of my said wife, all the remainder of my said lands and plantation and one cow provided my said wife can raise it on my estate and at my death ten pounds said to him and his heirs forever.

I then, I give and bequeath unto my three daughters (Viz) Elizabeth Cooper, Molly Cooper and Nancy Cooper one half and furniture each to them and their heirs forever.

I then I leave the use of all my lands and plantation and all the remainder of my estate, of what nature or kind soever, unto my said wife to dispose of for during her natural life or widowhood, and after her marriage or death to equally divide the same then remaining amongst all my children.

Lastly, I appoint my friend Jacob Cardow son, and my beloved wife Frances Cooper, executor to this my last will and testament, seeking and discharging as former will and wife by me hitherto made, and allowing this and no other to be my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 21st day of October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand ^{seventy} ~~eight~~ ^{eighty} ~~nine~~ ^{hundred} and ninety-two.

I John Lewis of the county of Southampton and parish of St Lukes being in my perfect senses do make this my last will and testament (Viz)

I then, I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Lewis all my lands, viz the plantation whereon I now live, the plantation I purchased of Edward King the plantation I purchased of blackbone Hannu (provided after he gets possession of his possession of his estate, that he maintain my daughter with her board and clothing until they marry, if he comply with the above said

I then give the said lands to him and his heirs forever. I also give to my son Benjamin Lewis my gun and my silver table and tea spoons to him and his heirs forever.

I then I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Lewis my negro man I have to him and his heirs forever.

I then I give and bequeath unto my four children Benjamin Lewis, Mary Lewis, Nancy Lewis and Rebecca Lewis all my negroes also all the property I own at my death or all my estate of every kind and whereunto I am to be legally entitled between all my children of them and their heirs forever.
