In the Name of God Amen I David Thomas of
 Southampton County being of Sound Mind & Memory do
 make and Ordain this to be my last Will and Testament
 in manner and form following (that is to say) —
 I lend to my wife Emily Thomas all my land whereon I now
 live during her natural life or widowhood but if she marries
 again my will and Desire is that she Only have the part
 of the land lying on the north side of the road where I
 now live I shall lend to her three Negroes, Six Cows & Ten
 two feather beds and coverings one Chest one Trunk —
 a womans saddle half dozen sitting chairs one spinning wheel
 one bag more five head of Cattle ten Choice Sheeps and two
 Doves two quos and Lambs and fifty Dollars and thirty Bushels
 of Corn ten Bushels wheat.

Item

I give to my son Nathans N. Thomas three Negroes to wife
 Maria Silva & Arthur & thier future increase to him and his heirs
 forever. I give to my son David H. Thomas after the death
 of my wife Emily Thomas all my land whereon I now live
 containing two hundred 35 acres more or less to him and his heirs
 forever & if my wife marries again the land lying on the
 South side of the road to be united and united my
 son David H. Thomas comes of age or marries for
