In the Name of God Amen I Josiah Vicks of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia, Knowing the uncertainty of human life but retaining the full possession of all my mental faculties do make and publish my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say In the first place. I lend unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Vicks for and during the term of her natural, all that part of the Plantation whereon I now live lying South of a line from the Cypress bridge road coming to my dwelling house across the yard and by the still house towards the river to what is called the gut and from thence along the meanders of the said gut to the creek of the Cypress bridge together with that half of my yard and garden which lies between thence One of the houses comprising my dwelling house, to be left to her own choice and all the outhouses, except the crib by the barn and the still house, of which last she is to have the use Only of the one half
