

Conveyed to me by William Woidards Containing by Estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less Subject however to the life estate in part thereof herein before devised to my wife Elizabeth Vick - the land which I bought of Benjamin Mistras Containing by estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less Subject to the operation of a deed of trust thereon for the benefit of Jacob Darden Administrator of Mills Everett deceased the land which I bought of John Rowd Subject to his own life estate therein Containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and half the plantation which I bought of Kerley Vick Containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less Subject to the Interest therein herein before devised to my wife Elizabeth Vick and one acre of land to be the same more or less near the Cypress bridge which I bought of Simmons Vick To have and to hold all the said tracts or parcels of land to my said son Richards Vick his heirs and assigns forever.

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Richard Vick the following Slaves to wit, Bob Tom Henry Nancy Melly Peter and Simon, also my bandy Hilt to him and his heirs forever.

Fifthly I give unto my beloved daughter Patsy Williams wife of Richard E. Williams the tract of land which I bought of Benjamin Johnson Containing by estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less Subject to the operation of a deed of Trust thereon for the benefit of Jacob Darden Administrator of Mills Everett deceased and the tract of land which I bought of John Pepper Containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five Acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said tracts or parcels of land to my said daughter Patsy Williams heirs heirs and assigns forever. Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Patsy Williams, wife of Richard E. Williams, the following Slaves, to wit, George Dickson Lavin Blackbolls Shalons Allen and Molly to her and her heirs forever. Seventhly I give unto my beloved daughter Jane Tinsdale called Sunday Vick, the tract or parcel of land which I bought of
