

Frances Clements commonly called this Betty Wick and  
 containing by estimation five hundred and fifty Acres, be then  
 James more or less and one half the Plantation which I  
 bought of Kirby Wick, containing by estimation one hundred  
 Acres be the same more or less and to be allotted to her by  
 line now from the river towards this Pepper Plantation  
 To have (and to hold the said tracts or parcels of land to my  
 said daughter Jane I usually called Simsey Wick her heirs  
 and assigns forever. But if my said daughter Jane I usually  
 called Simsey Wick should die during her Infancy or without  
 leaving lawful issue at the time of her death then it is my will  
 and desire that all the lands before devised to her, shall be  
 equally divided between my grand children Josiah Williams son  
 of Richard E Williams and Edwin Wick son of Richard Wick  
 and if either the said Josiah Williams or Edwin Wick  
 should die during his Infancy or without leaving lawful  
 issue at the time of his death then upon the death of my  
 said daughter Jane I usually called Simsey Wick, during her  
 Infancy or without leaving lawful issue at the time of her  
 death it is my will and desire that all the lands divided  
 to her as aforesaid, shall go to my son Richard Wick his  
 heirs and assigns forever. Eighthly, I give and bequeath unto  
 my beloved daughter Jane I usually called, Simsey Wick the  
 following Slaves to wit, Jacob Sam, Clements, Charles,  
 Betty, Minny and Jates Harrah and Fates Harrah,  
 also two beds, two chests and furniture, the Chest of Draw-  
 and a side Saddle called hers to her and her heirs forever.  
 Ninthly, it is my will and desire that my lots in Jerusalem  
 called the tavern lot and Groves lot and the lands stable  
 and tenements adjoining, shall be sold and conveyed by my  
 Executors herein after named, who are hereby authorized to sell  
 the same, together or Separately, either at publick or private  
 Sale (and on such terms as they shall Judge Best and  
 the money arising from such Sale they are to distribute  
 equally among all my children and if my wife Elizabeth
