

Eleventhly it is my will and desire that my wife Elizabeth Vick have the liberty of Distilling her brandy in my brandy still herein before given to to my son Richard Vick, without paying any tax or other piece thereof.

Twelfthly, it is my will and desire that my daughters - Patsy Williams, wife of Richard E. Williams, and Saml Vick ally Called Sundry Vick each pay to my son Richard Vick the sum of twenty five Dollars annually during the life of my wife Elizabeth Vick, in consideration of my said wife having a life estate in part of the land divided to him, But if my said wife should refused to accept of the provision made for her in my last will and Testament (and demand) I over in my estate then the said annuity is to cease.

Thirteenthly It is my will and desire that my son Richard Vick allow my Negroes Casar and his wife Hiram and to live in the house in the Soil Dogal field and to rear and tend a crop for their support on any the adjoining lands he may think proper to assign to them and if the said Negroes from age or otherwise should become unable to maintain themselves then it is my will and desire that all my Children contribute equally to their support.

Fourteenthly, I hereby appoint my friend Griffin Stick guardian to my daughter Saml Usually Called, Sundry Vick, and vest him with full powers for the proper Control of her person and property, at the same time particularly requesting that she may reside in his family.

Fifteenthly, I hereby appoint my friends Samuel Calvert Jacob Jordan, Samuel Kiler and Henry Poler or any three of them, to act in Conjunction with Commissioners who may be appointed by the Executors of William Evans deceased in settling and adjusting all the private and partnership transactions between myself and the said Evans, being anxious that the unsettled affairs between us should be
