 of any part of my estate but that the whole of my estate
 not heretofore given away, be equally divided amongst
 my wife, my Son Abalom and my daughter Polly
 Smith, so soon after my decease as could be to the interest
 of my estate to make such division.
 Item it is my Will and desire that the whole of my estate
 both real and personal, left to be divided amongst my wife
 & two Children, be divided by Thomas Dupree son
 Lewis Dupree, Joshua C. Lindy, Arthur Williamson
 James Harris, Japh Hobb, & Newell Harris or any three
 or more of them Item my Will and desire is, That after the
 division aforesaid that my son Abalom have Stock
 of all kinds and his other personal estate be kept together
 on his said Plantation, for the purpose of making
 a crop, under the Control and management of my Execu-
 -tors hereafter named and appointed, until he arrives or
 comes of the age of twenty one years, Subject to my Executors
 discretion in selling any of the Stock or Crops that my Son
 needs or purchasing any Stock that may be necessary.
 Item it is also my Will and desire that my daughter
 Smiths Negroes Stock of all kinds and other personal estate
 be kept together on her said lands, in the same manner
 and under the same rules and regulations as my son
 Abalom are to be kept on his plantations during the
 time she remains unmarried or until she arrives to the age
 of twenty one years. Item my Will and desire further is
 that if my said daughter Polly Smith should die
 before she should attain the age of twenty five years with-
 out lawful child or children living at the time of her death
 then I give all the estate, both real and personal heretofore
 devised & bequeathed to her to my son Abalom Smith
