At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 1st day
of January 1813 To writing purporting to be the last Will
& Testament of Henry Smith deceased was presented in Court
and Grev Turner one of the Executors therein named ren-
ounced his right of testacy and was examined as a witness and
it appearing from the testimony of said Grev Turner and
other witnesses examined by the Court that the said paper
contain a distribution of the personal estate of the said
Henry Smith deceased agreeing with what he declared to the
said witnesses to be the distribution he had made thereof,
moreover that the said paper was written by the said
Grev Turner by the direction of the said Henry Smith
afterwards approved by him and moreover that he the
said Henry Smith did not express to any of the said witnesses
in his lifetime any wish to alter his said Will except as to a
tract of land purchased by him after the making thereof
wherefore it is considered by the Court that the said last Will
& Testament be established as the Will of the said Henry
Smith deceased so far and so far only as to pass the personal
estate to which the said Henry Smith deceased was entitled - and
on the motion of Etheldred Smith one of the Executors named
in the said Will probate is granted him this day whereupon
the said Etheldred Smith gave bond (the Will directing no
security to be given by the Exet) and thereupon the said
Etheldred qualified according to law.
