

In obedience to an order of the County Court of Southampton, the undersigned, have examined stated and sette an account current of the transactions of James Harrison with the estate of Abelon Williams deceased since the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1809 as stated with in - where it will be seen that £<sup>0</sup> is given the estate for an expected Judgment in Hartford Superior Court, which when fully red by Mr. Harrison, will leave him in debt to the estate the sum of £ 61 13s 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ p as within stated - Given under our hand this 10th Octr 1810

In the Name of God amen, I do lette Seve of the County of Southampton and Parish of Notterway being sick and weak in body but of a perfect sound mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows, viz.

Item I leave unto my beloved wife Ann Seve the two of my plantations together with all the remains of Estate during her induction or life and at her death or marriage, I give unto my son John Seve my land plantation whereon I now live containing by estimation 58 acres to the same more or less, also One New gun and Plantation Utensils, to him and his heirs forever - Item I give unto my son John Seve One Cow and Calf and ten pounds Cash to him and his heirs forever -

Item and it is my will and desire that at the death or marriage of my said wife that all the remains of my whole estate not above mentioned shall equally divided between my four daughters namely Sophia, Polly, Edmunds, Mason, Diven & Nancy Harrison Seve, to them and their heirs forever but provided my wife should die before my youngest daughter should arrive to the age of seven years, it is my desire that this should be so much raised off my estate as may be thought sufficient to support her for that term of time.
