In the Name of God amen I Nathaniel Wilkinson of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia do Make and constitute and ordain this my last will and testament in the following manner
 It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid by my Executors hereafter to be nominated.
 I give to my living wife Ann & Wilkinson. My Negro woman named Huldah and her two children named Eddy and Slay - My Six and a half and two horses of her own choice and the sum of One hundred and fifty doll and to be paid to her out of my estate by my Executors annually during during her natural life all of which I give to her and her heirs and assigns forever.
 I give to my living wife Ann & Wilkinson during her natural life the following property vizt My Negro Man John Sen. Lewis Sen. Joel Marrow and woman also the situation where I now live including only the land which is now in an orchard near the marsh My Garden yard and all the land lying between the dwelling house and the Gate at the road within the same spaces together with all the dwelling houses and out houses belonging to the said situation - also all my household and kitchen furniture of every description.
 I give to my living wife Ann & Wilkinson during her widowhood:
