will & testament) to wit, all the lands (except twenty acres which will
hereafter be directed to be sold) I purchase of William Barnes & Isaac
Vick, as will appear by their deeds record in the County Court of Southamp-
ton containing five hundred and eighty six acres, with the appurtenances
and husbandry, thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to her
(and her heirs forever)

I give and bequeath to my said beloved wife Francis Calvert, all my Negroes,
to wit, Aggy, Fow, Dora, and Sall, One half of all my stock of Hens,
Hogs, Cattle and Sheep, Household & Kitchen furniture, plantation
implements, crop of Brandy, Corn, peas & fodder to her (and her heirs
forever) in division of all or any of the above mentioned articles, it is
my will and desire & I hereby authorize my Executors to give and
allow to my said beloved wife Francis Calvert the Privilege of
selecting and taking any of the articles of Household & Kitchen furniture
stock & Plantation Implements at the appraised value in part or in whole
of her estate
