In the name of God Amen I Susanna Hines the last do make (and ordain this my last will and testament of first I leave my soul to God who gave it me (and my body to be decently buried at the direction of my Executors to be buried hereafter and as to such worldly goods as I have I leave to be divided among my dear children as follows to wit

I leave to my daughter Martha Hinch one dollar
I leave to my daughter Susanna Hines one Dollar
I leave to William Hines Fells my bay horse & bridle
and my gun.

I leave to my handmaiden Susanna Pappert Fells the bed whereon I lay (and one spinning wheel

I leave to my handmaid Henry Fells one feather bed and furniture

The remainder part of my estate of whatsoever kind or quality after my just debts are paid I leave to be equally divided between my three children Sally Hines Fells, Patsy Fells & John Williams Hines Fells or their legal representatives

Lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Perry P. Pappert whole & Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament utterly disannulling and revoking all other wills by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 31st day of July One thousand eight hundred and thirteen
