heirs forever also all my estate of what nature or kind soever
I am in case my executors shall feel to pay to Capt John Brichlow the
sum which I am indebted to the said Brichlow & for which
he has obtained Judgment with Cost in the County Court of Southampton
Co. Me. within three months after my decease then there is
that case my executor hereafter named is directed to bring Suit
against my said father John Woodward Senr for the amount
of the said due me (and which hath been heretofore put in
the hands of J. Still) & to institute Suit thereon and upon
the recovery thereof to pay the said John Brichlow his claim &
I hereby appoint William Wood and my Executor to this my will
and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
Name at Fort Nelson Va this 6 June 1813
