I give and bequeath to my son Silas Barnes the tract of land I purchased of Ephraim Bryant together with the tract (or parcel) of land I purchased of Jonas Bryant also the property he now has in ^{his} possession of mine, to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Lydia Barrett, fifteen hundred dollars in good Bonds or money, one feather bed and furniture (second choice), one horse (second choice), one chair and harness & one Ladies Saddle, to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Dardew, two hundred & fifty dollars in good Bonds or money, also the property she now has in her possession of mine to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son John Barrett the tract of land now his own, also the tract of land I purchased of Ezeke Barrett containing 331 acres be the same more or less, also one other tract of land formerly belonging to William Jackson, containing 80 acres more or less, also twelve hundred dollars in good Bonds or money to him and his heirs forever
