do hereby make this my last will and testament in manner
and form following that is to say -

1st I desire that my Executors hereafter named do have my estate
amicably appraised after my decease as the law directs -

2nd I lend to my wife Tabitha Bishops two hundred dollars value
of my estate of whatever kind she my said wife may have then
possession of my estate I desire should and out of the money arising
from such all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid
3rd I desire that the remaining part of my estate after the Comple-
tion of the above proportions be subject to the Support and
Education of my Children

4th I desire that my Executors hereafter named may at any time
when ever they have the opportunity apply the whole or
any part of my estate to the purchase of a tract of land
