

The Clerk read to us of the County Court of Southampton was a true and correct
 signed and examined stated and settled an account current of the
 transactions of life estate with the estate of Thomas Gregory &c
 who like the part of the county sometimes before his death and went
 to the state of Ohio and stayed in the town of Marietta, leaving
 his family, in which place he gave a bond to a Mr. McFarland
 for \$100 for which sum the said Mr. McFarland brought suit
 against Mr. Gregory who had not administered on the estate of his
 deceased husband yet when she was about to leave the state of Ohio she
 was compelled to give security; and Doct^r Jay then became her friend
 in the case who wrote to Mr. Baile for a copy of his administration
 in this state which Mr. Baile informs us he sent an agent to
 request; and the copy appears to have been a sufficient proof
 to that Court that she just had been brought against the
 wrong person; therefore Mr. McFarland was nonsuited and it is
 not yet known by Mr. Baile whether the said Mr. McFarland
 will send his claim on here for payment or not; therefore we
 mention these circumstances to this Court in order that Mr.
 Baile's return for holding the \$100 may be known, should
 he be called on by the friends or heirs of the above named decd.
 for the full balance that may appear without taking
 out the \$100 before a sufficient time is given to determine
 whether Mr. McFarland will recover from Mr. Baile
 or not should he not recover the \$100 of Mr. Baile the
 balance due the estate will be \$107.1.9¹¹ Should he
 recover the \$100 -- of Mr. Baile the balance then due
 the estate will be \$77.1.9¹¹ Given under our hands this
