being in Sound mind and memory do Make and Ordain this my last Will
and Testament in manner and form of following to wit

Item) to my loving wife Polly Butts during her life the use of the land and
Plantation I give her with all the stock of every kind with all the
household and kitchen furniture also all the plantation utensils I also
leave her the following negroes to wit Lucy, Nancy, No, Dary, Jim Dard,
Will, Pitt, Lucy Patti and George

Item) give unto my son John Butts wherein he resides under the following
boundary to wit Beginning at the bridge on the Parkton Stump and
running down the run of said stump to a small branch thence up the said
branch a Spanish oak on the road and from thence to the beginning
I also give him two negroes to wit Jim and Amy & also give him one horse
bridle and saddle one feather bed and furniture all of which property he now
lives in his possession I also give him my eighth part of the estate of
Thomas William — Jim doth which is now in the possession of Abel —
Champer, the property hitherto mentioned I give to him and his heirs forever

Item) I give unto my son James Butts the land and plantation wherein he
now lives containing One hundred and fifty one acres I also give him two
negroes to wit wife and Hannah One horse bridle and saddle One
double to and furnished to him and his heirs forever

Item) I give unto my daughter Nancy Butts the following negroes to wit
Ephriam, Lucy and Hannah, and one feather bed and furniture to her and her
heirs forever

Item) I give unto my son Edwin Butts after the death of my wife, the land
and Plantation wherein I now live under the following instructions my
daughter shall have full Right to as house and home without the
charge of board until they comes of age or marry I also give him one Walnut
Bush One Walnut table one Walnut Chairs one horse Bridle & saddle
one feather bed and furniture I also give him the following negroes to wit
Tom and Easter to him and his heirs forever

Item) I give unto my daughter Elly Butts the negroes to wife Peter and Simkey
I also give her one of other bgs and furniture to her and her heirs forever
