At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 17th of January 1814 This will was presented in Court by Samuel Jones
One of the Executors therein named proved by the oaths of Abraham Row and Matthew Westray two of the Witnesses thereto and said to be recited, and on the motion of said Samuel Jones exec of the executors named in the will, the other refusing, to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof, certificate is granted him for obtaining probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon —

In the Name of God Amen, I David Pearson of the County of Southampton being call'd to Norfolk in defence of my Country & not knowing that I shall ever return, do make & ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner following to wit I give and bequeath to my Mother, to her and her heirs forever all my interest in my Father's estate together with all my estate of what ever kind to be in anywise appertaining or belonging, provided further she shall pay all my just debts, and also pay unto Robert Moore one dollar to pay my funeral expenses at the Raven Steam Maling house lastly I nominate her the said Sarah Pearson sole Exec to this my last will & it is my will that the Court shall not require security for her performance in Es^{ts} & % in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th day of June 1813 —

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 17th day of January 1814 This writing purporting to be the last will and testament of David Pearson, was presented in Court by Sarah Pearson the Executrix therein named and Sam'l Danson and Richard P. Clements, deposed that they believed as well as the body of said
