Item It is my will and desire that the debt which is now owing me to  
Henry Parker for or about the sum of twenty eight pounds shoule  
not be paid because I consider that I was cheated and defrauded  
out of the sum of £ 200.  
Item It is my will and desire that the debt which I owe to James  
Dixwell by note should be paid to him by four annual  
installments, the first payment to commence at Christmas  
next.  
Item It is my will and desire that the said instrust bequeathed by me  
to Charles Fozant Conveyed to him as trustee my House and  
lot in the town of Jerusalem to satisfy a debt due to James  
Jackson as Executor of James Wilkinson dec'd. Should he fail  
on or before the first day of June next, and the aforesaid  
house and lot be released from that incumbrance.  
Item All the land which I may here after devise by purchase  
or otherwise I give and devise to my beloved wife Elizabeth  
Hart for maintaining the term of her natural life only.  
Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Nephew Lewis P Hart  
all the balances of my estate both real and personal, which I  
have not already disposed of, including the remainder in the  
real and personal estate which I have heretofore devised  
and bequeathed unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Hart for  
and during the term of her natural life, to him his heirs  
and assigns forever.  
Lastly Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my Nephew Lewis  
P Hart, and my friend Collin Kitchens, Executors to this my  
last will and testament; hereby revoking and disannulling  
all other wills and testaments by me heretofore made  
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
affixed my seal this first day of April 1814 —  
Signed, sealed, published and declared  
by the said Wm Hart to be his last  
will and testament in presence of  
C. Wadlow  
James Rochelle  
At a Court held for the County of  
Southampton the day of April 1814 the Will was presented  
in Court by Lewis P Hart one of the Executors therein named & Collin  
Kitchens the other Executor named refusing in open Court to qualify  
and bound by the oaths of C. Wadlow and James Rochelle the  
Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recited. On the motion of the said  
Executor who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for  
obtaining a protest thereof in due form so being given and security deposited
