I do make this piece of Writing to be my Last will and Testament in manner and form following (w)
I give and bequeath to my Sister Abby Preffed the following Negroes, Dasy, Nelson, Buckley & young Child, also the land and plantation on the Broad water Head with the law I purchased of Moses Hart, likewise the three parts of my two Slaves to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Sarah Harris the Land and plantation that was formerly my brother Eason Harris' with the following Negroes, Tom, Abby and Child Fanny, Tempy and Minsey, also one third part of my two Slaves to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Lucy Harris the Land and plantation whereon I now live also the following Negroes Ann, Dick, Cherry, Luiza, also one third part of my two Slaves to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Joel Preffed my Negro Man Lewis, three hundred and fifty Dollars — to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Joshua Preffed my Negro boy Ben three hundred and fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Niece Sarah Preffed my two Negro Girls Melly and Berline, two hundred Dollars to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Niece Eliza Brantley when she shall arrive to the age of twenty one years one thousand Dollars, to be paid her by my Executor hereafter named and if she should die before she arrives to the age of twenty one years, the Legacy to be equally provided between my three Sisters already named or their heirs —

Item I give all the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever (that is not already given away) to my three Sisters to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever —

I constated my friend William Bailey my whole and sole Executor to fulfill this my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have thereto set my hand and Seal this 25th day of April 1814 —
