In the name of God amen I Matthew Calvert of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of Sound mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (to wit)

First I give and bequeath to Fanny Doyal and Squally Doyal, children of Wm Doyal, the sum of three hundred Dollars each to be paid to them by my executor in the following manner and conditions (to wit) the sum of thirty Dollars annually to each on conditions that my executor (to be hereafter named) take and have the sole care, management and direction of the said Legacies and persons of the said Fanny & Squally Doyal; If the said Fanny and Squally Doyal or either of them die before the time requested to receive all of the said Legacies. It is my will and desire and I hereby give and bequeath whatsoever remaining balance there may be Equally to my Nephews Samuel Calvert, Bapell Mosely Calvert, Matthew Calvert, John Marden Calvert and William Calvert to them and their heirs forever —

2^d I give and bequeath to my Nephews Samuel Calvert, Bapell Mosely Calvert, Matthew Calvert, John Marden Calvert and William Calvert, all my negroes namely Bob, Charles, Jacob, Champions, George & Sally, and all others that I may die seized and possessed of, and all the residue of my Estate of every kind or nature whatsoever. Debts due to me or otherwise, It is my will and desire and I hereby authorize and empower my executor to make sale of all of said Negroes as well as all the residue of my estate of every kind or nature whatsoever, on twelve months Credit (or any way he may deem most advantageous) after my Just Debts are paid, to be equally Divided between my said Nephews, Samuel Calvert, Bapell Mosely Calvert, Matthew Calvert, John Marden Calvert and William Calvert — them and their heirs forever —

lastly I Nominate and appoint my Nephew Samuel Calvert Executor to this my Last will and Testament, given under my hand and Seal this 3^d day of November 1813 —
