to this my last will and testament in Witness I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this first day of January 1814 —

executor refusing to qualify, and on the motion of Jesse Vick who
made oath according to Law for administration with the Will annexed

also one hundred pounds in silver or gold also one Bed and furniture
to her and her heirs forever —

My will and desire is that my executor hereafter to be appointed
may remove me from this place to be buried on Compying with
this request, Give all the remainder and residue of my estate to
Martha Miller Wife of Cap^t James Miller to her and her heirs
forever — Lastly I do nominate and appoint my friend Cap^t James
Miller, Executor to this my last will and testament revoking all
