Item I give and bequeath to my son Lisha Gay after the death of his mother my Land and one bed and furniture one gun and one Bible to him and his heirs forever — the balance of my estate to be sold and all my just debts paid off and the remainder to be equally divided between both of my children —

Item I do appoint William Wills and Anthony Wills my Executors to this my last will and testament in witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of January 1814 —

I give and bequeath to Martha Sumner Stewart now the wife of Mr. Richard Stewart, my negro man by the name of Jacob also one hundred pounds in Silver or gold also one bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever —

My will and desire is that my executor hereafter to be appointed may remove me from this place to be buried on Long Island with this request, Give all the remainder and residue of my estate to Martha Miller Wife of Capt James Miller to her and her heirs forever — Lastly I do nominate and appoint my friend Capt James Miller Executor to this my last will and testament revoking all
