do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in

Imprimis

I leave the use of my plantation and Tract of Land wherein I now
live to my beloved wife Honor Pipes during her natural life or
widowhood, and after her death or marriage I give the said
plantation and Tract of Land to my Son Rubens Richard Pipe
to him and his heirs forever also one leather bed and furniture
but in case he dies under the age of twenty one years and
without Issue I then give the said Land to be equally
divided ~~between~~ among my four Daughters namely Nancy
Johnson Rhoda Pipe Lucy Pipe and Sophia Pipe to them
and their heirs forever —

Item

I also leave unto my wife Honor Pipes all my household and kitchen
furniture of every description also all my Stock of Cows, Cattle
Sheep and Hogs and all my plantation utensils during her natural
life or widowhood, and after her death or marriage I give the
said Legacy to be equally divided amongst my Daughters Nancy
Johnson Rhoda Pipe, Lucy Pipe and Sophia Pipe to them and
their heirs forever —
