

At a court held for the County of Southampton the 15th
day of August 1814 this account current of the estate of
John Hart deceased was returned to Court and ordered to be recorded

Joseph
Hart
Will -

I Joseph Hart deceased of the County of Southampton being of
sound mind and memory do make and draw this writing to be my last will and testament
Item It is my will and desire that my son Joseph Hart shall possess the land wherein I
now live containing one hundred acres more or less that I say if he should have
a lawful issue but if my said son Joseph Hart dies without lawful issue
in that case I give the said land to my son Joshua Hart to him and his heirs
forever - I also give my son Joseph Hart two negroes (to wit) Dick and Solomon
and five pounds Cash to him and his heirs forever -

Item - I give my son Sippe Hart the land and plantation wherein he now
lives. Containing one hundred and twenty acres. more or less - to him and
his heirs forever - I also give my son Joseph Hart two negroes (to wit) Dick and Solomon
and five pounds Cash to him and his heirs forever -

Item - I give to my Daughter Sarah Hart the following property (that)
one Negroe man (Charles) one feather bed and furniture one chest one loom
and harness - two Spinning Wheels (Wooden & linen) to her & her heirs forever
I also give my Daughter Sarah the use of the house that I formerly
lived in and as much Cotton & potato ground convenient to the house as
she may think proper to make Cotton and potatoes on for the family's use
and as much fire wood as she may think necessary for the use of the
family during her single life, and at her marriage or death. I give
the said house, cotton and potato ground. for word to, to my son Joshua
Hart, to him and to his heirs forever -

Item - I give my Son Hartwell Hart the land and plantation wherein my
son George Hart deceased formerly lived containing one hundred and thirty acres
more or less, and one Negro man (to wit) Lewis one feather bed and furniture
to him and his heirs forever -

Item - I give my son Joshua Hart the land and plantation wherein I now
live. Containing two hundred and forty acres. more or less - except the use of the
house I formerly live in, together with some Cotton and Potato ground. for word
to I give to my Daughter Sarah During her single life. I also give to
my said son Joshua one negro man (to wit) Simon one feather bed and
furniture to him and to his heirs forever -

Item - I give to my Son Hartwell Hart. twenty pounds Cash to him and to his
heirs forever -

Item - I give to my Son Joshua Hart of yeare past two pounds Cash and one old
Negro Woman Lucy to him and to his heirs forever

Item - I give to my Stephen Samuel Bailey one Dollar to him
and his heirs forever -

Item - I give to my Stephen Joseph Bailey one Dollar to him and his heirs forever

Item - I give to my Stephen Bailey one dollar to him and his heirs forever
