In The Name of God Amen I Matthew Wells of Southampton County Virginia being of said and disposing mind but for advanced age, and calling to my recollection the Morality of my body, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (S. P. T.)

First — I give and bequeath unto my son William Wells, his heirs and assigns forever the land plantation and appurtenances which I bought of Dempsy Johnson, it being the land on which my said Son now lives;

Item, I give and bequeath to my son John Wells the land which I bought of Abington Jones Simon Murphy and William Lawrence Call's Turkey Island. I also give him my fourth part of the ferry and land adjoining which John Rochelle and myself bought of Baker & Cole Lying on Cheamus River opposite
