Item - I give and bequeath to my grand son Thomas Will (son of my son Thomas Will dec'd) that divided aspect of land given or left in the following boundaries - land beginning at the plantation of my late and the lands of Abraham Mitchell dec'd at Nottoway river running thence along said Mitchell line to the Buzzard pond thence up said pond to a pine thence along a line of marked trees - to a Hickory a corner tree of the lands of Henry Briggs dec'd - thence along Briggs line to Nottoway river thence down the river to the beginning to the house and adjacent power - subject however to the use of my family and estate of his mother Peggy Will Widow of my late son Thomas Will dec'd - for and during her life in widowhood which power I hereby give her -

Item - all the residue of my land lying about and including the mansion house and plantation, together with all its improvements and appurtenances except the two Mills which are not hereby covered with land, but shall be considered as separate; and subject to the service therefrom of mead &c - I give and bequeath to my son James Will and to him his heirs and assigns forever - I also give him one bed and furniture and my old negro man Ned

Item - I hereby confirm to my son in law James Edwards, his heirs & assigns forever the title to a negro woman named Pat, and her increase (now in his possession) and my will and desire is, that my said son in law James Edwards, should have no part portion or interest whatever in any other part of my estate -

Item - I hereby confirm to my Daughter Elizabeth Vaughan, her heirs and assigns forever - the gift and title to a negro girl Hannah and her children now in her possession -

Item - I give to my Daughter Catherine Will one negro boy Peter and one bed and furniture, to her, her heirs and assigns forever -

Item - I give to my Daughter Charity Vaughan one negro boy Abraham and five pound cash, to her, her heirs and assigns forever -

Item - I give to my Daughter Temperance W Will, one negro boy Jacob and one bed and furniture, to her, her heirs and assigns forever -

Item - I give to my three grand children Piercy Pope Betty Pope and Solomon Pope to each ten pound cash, to be paid over by my exec^r to their guardians herein after appointed, in case he will act, other wise to such person as may lawfully represent them -

Item - I give to my Daughter Ann Will one hundred Dollars -

Item - I give to my grand son Thos^d Edwards one hundred Dollars -

Item - I desire Will and direct that all my Slaves not herein before said should be set up and sold to the highest bidder amongst my seven Children following (to wit) William Will Elizabeth Vaughan Catherine Will John Will Charity Vaughan James Will and Temperance W Will and that no other should be suffered to bid or become a purchaser save those seven or their legal Representatives and the proceeds of such Sale
