

Then I give to my son Shadrack Vaughan one negro boy Sam to him and his heirs and assigns forever —

Then I give to my Daughter Betty Vaughan one negro girl Dinah and in reward to her and her heirs and assigns forever

Then I give to my son Matthew Vaughan one negro boy, slave to him and his heirs and assigns forever —

Then I give to my son Thomas Vaughan, one negro boy Saunders to him and his heirs and assigns forever —

Then I give to my son Sigmund Vaughan, one negro girl Aggy and her increase to him and his heirs and assigns forever

Then I give to my son William Vaughan one negro boy Bala to him and his heirs and assigns forever —

Then I bequeath the use of my beloved wife Elizabeth Vaughan during her life in widowhood, and negro boy Harry and two Wharves Betty and Hannah, and it is my intention and I do hereby devise that in case my wife should marry that then she shall be entitled to and receive the same portion of my estate both real and personal, as she by law would have been entitled to if I had died without Will —

Then I leave all the residue of my estate of every nature or kind, to be sold (including the three negroes left to the use of my wife at her death or marriage) and the amount thereof, I give to be equally divided amongst all my children then living or their descendants —

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my two sons Shadrack Vaughan and Henry Vaughan to be the executors of this my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I the said Sigmund Vaughan have hereunto set my hand and Seal the 22nd day of October 1814

At a court held for the County of Southampton the 2nd day of November 1814 the Will was presented in Court by the executor, proved by the oaths of Kimball Cold and Cowling Cooper two of the testators thereof and ordered to be Recorded and on the motion of Shadrack Vaughan one of the executors named (the other refusing to qualify) who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form who gave bond and security Whereupon &c —
