¶ I nominate and appoint my Sons George Hines and Samuel B. Hines for the special purpose of acting as Trustees, together in behalf of their Brother William D. Hines, to whom I give and devise to Long as he lives, a decent and comfortable Support, with all necessary apparel at the expence of my Son Samuel as aforesaid; and I do moreover authorise and require my said Sons to see that this provision is uniformly and to the best advantage carried into effect in his favour, and moreover will and authorise them on pay such a charge in my said Sons habis and conduct that happily take place, so as to give a well founded hope of a sober and correct conduct, that they my said two Sons in their mutual discretion, may not only afford to my said Son the annual Support as aforesaid, allowed him, but also allow him such other benefits and profits, or vest him absolutely with such other property to be taken from my estate, as they shall be of opinion a more correct and sober conduct should meet on his part.

¶ All the rest and residue of my estate not mentioned or provided for, after the payment of any debts and legacies as mentioned, I devise to the use of my wife, and to be disposed of as she may think proper -

¶ I nominate and appoint my Sons George Hines and Samuel B. Hines, as executors of this my Last Will and Testament, disallowing all others, which under my hand and Seal this fifth day of January Eighteen hundred and fifteen
