Still My will and desire is that all the residue of my estate of every kind what ever, that not before given or loaned away to be paid, and the money arising from the sale thereof be applied in the first place to the payment of my just debts, then to the payment of the one hundred and fifty Dollars left to my Daughter Mary Holmes, and the balance if any to be equally divided between my Children namely Sarah Holmes, James Holmes, Samuel Holmes, Meldora Holmes, Virginia Holmes, and William H Holmes, to them and their heirs forever Lastly I do nominate and appoint my Wife Nancy Holmes, my Son John Holmes, and my Brother in Law James Clayton, Executor & Executrix of this my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal the 1st day of June Eighteen hundred and twelve
