In the name of god amen I Presley Barrett, of the County of Southampton, being in a debilitated State of body and very weak but of perfect sound mind and memory, Thanks be to almighty god for the same, do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament, in manner and form following (to Wit)

In the first place, I commend my Soul to the great and almighty God, who first gave it, and my body to the dust from whence it came, and desire that my friends may bury me therein in a decent and comely manner, and then it is my sincere desire, that my Executor, whom I shall hereafter nominate and appoint to this my Last will and Testament, may after my decease, pay all my Just debts out of my estate and then -
