In the Name of God amen I James Ramsey of Southampton County and State of Virginia do hereby make my last will and testament in Manner and form following, that is to say
1st I give to my son David Ramsey one negro boy named Sam one Bed which he has in possession two head of Cattle to him and his heirs forever -
2^d I give to my son Jacob Ramsey two negroes named Halle and Amby five head of Cattle one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever -
3rd I give to my Daughter Nancy Claude three Negroes
