

Slaves, namely Henry and Jimmy, Eight head of Cattle which she has now in possession. Also one Towel Belt to her and her heirs forever —
 1st I give to my Daughter Catherine Ramsey two negroes named Lucy and Charles, one feather bed and furniture, five head of Cattle and one bay gilly to her and her heirs forever —

2nd I give to my son William Ramsey the Land whereon I now lived containing by estimation two hundred and 67 1/2 acres be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever — Two Negroes named Old Jimmy and Simon to him and his heirs forever —

3rd My will and desire is that all my stock of sheep should be equally divided between my son Jacob Ramsey and my Daughter Catherine Ramsey which I give to them and their heirs forever —

4th It is my will and desire that my negroes named Old Cesar young Cesar and Abram and all the rest of my estate that I have not disposed of, to be sold on a Credit of twelve months, and the money arising therefrom, to be equally divided between my several Children, named David, Jacob, Nancy, Catherine and William Ramsey to them and their heirs forever

And Lastly I do hereby Constitute and appoint my Son Jacob Ramsey and William Clarke, Executors of this my Last will and Testament, hereby revoking all other former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made, I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 29th day of January Eighteen hundred and fifteen —
