I give to my Daughter Catherine Ramsey two negroes named Lucy and Charles, one feather bed and furniture, five head of cattle and one bay gelding to her and her heirs forever —

I give to my son William Ramsey the Land wherein I now live containing by estimation two hundred and 672 acres to be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever — Two Negroes named

John and Simon to him and his heirs forever —

My will and desire is that all my flock of sheep should be equally divided between my son Jacob Ramsey and my Daughter Catherine Ramsey which I give to them and their heirs forever —

It is my will and desire that my negroes named old Caesar, young Caesar and abram and all the rest of my estate that I have not disposed of, to be sold on a credit of twelve monthly, and the money arising therefrom, to be equally divided between my several children, named David, Jacob, Nancy, Catherine and William Ramsey to them and their heirs forever

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son Jacob Ramsey and William Claude, Executrix of this my Last will and testament, hereby revoking all other former wills or Testaments, by me heretofore made, I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 29th day of January eighteen hundred and fifteen —
