

In the Name of god amen I Richard Pond of the County of Southampton being at this time weak in body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following -
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Pond one negro girl named Dinah; and one feather bed and furniture (which she has received) to her and her heirs forever -
 I give to my son James Pond, whom I likewise constitute make and ordain the sole executor of this my Last will and Testament all my Land Negroes, and all the residue of my estate of every kind what ever - not herein before mentioned, to him and his heirs forever -
 It is my will and desire that the trust require no security of my said executor for the settlement of my estate and that there be no appraisement in my estate in Writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 30th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 20th day of February 1815 this will was presented in Court by the executor, Proved by the oaths of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded - and on the motion of James Pond the executor therein named who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form who gave bond and security whereupon &c -

I Jacob Bradshaw of Southampton County do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following -
 I Give to my Daughter Lydia Rellings, during her Life one negro girl Rose, and after her death, I give her the said negro to her children - Lawfully begotten - to them and their heirs forever -
 I Give to my Daughter Nancy, during her Life one negro girl Easter and after her death, I give the said negro to her children Lawfully begotten, to them and their heirs forever, also one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever -
 I Give to my Daughter Milly, During her Life one negro girl Vinny, and after her death, I give the said negro to her children Lawfully begotten, to them and their heirs forever, also one feather bed and furniture, I give to her and her heirs forever
