Thomas Redley In the name of god amen I Thomas Redley last of Southampton County being in my perfect senses do make this to be my last will and Testament

Witness I Give to my wife the Land and Plantation whereon I now live with my work horses on the said Plantation, the Stock of hogs, horned Cattle and ten head of Sheep that are also on the same plantation, also two good feather beds (her choice) and one half of all the other household and Kitchen furniture, also all the plantation themselves, The Crop of all kinds made on the said Plantations, Also the following Negroes, Lewis, Dook, Pompey, Robin, Hannah, Meggie, Dinah and Cynthia, the following Property I Give to my Wife Anne during her natural life in lieu of her Dower -

Item - I give to my son Thomas Redley all the Land Lying on the north side of the main road Leading from Kinston to Beaufort, together with all the negroes which now are on the said Land, and Plantation and their future Increase together with every species of property on the said Land, to him the said Thomas and to his heirs forever -

Item - I also give and devise to my son Thomas one half of the proceeds of the sale of my Land which lies in the State of Ohio, which said Land I have conditionally sold to
