

James McKimley of the State of Kentucky, but in case the said sale should not be effectual, I then give to my said son Thomas, one half of the said Land, to him and to his heirs forever.

Item - I also give to my said son and require him from all claim and demand of with the money which I paid to John Wright, rent in consideration of a Tract of Land, purchased by my said son Thomas, of the said Wright, and for which said Land the said Wright made to my said son Thomas a conveyance which is recorded, in Southampton County Court.

Item I give and devise to my son Francis Ridley, at the death of his mother, all the estate of every kind, I have sent to him also all the residue of my Land lying on the South side of the main road leading from Jerusalem to Burgin, together with all the Slaves and their future increase, that are on the said Land, as also all other and every species of property which may be on the said Land (excepting the Loan made to his Mother during her Life) to him and to his heirs forever.

Item I also give and devise to my said son Francis, one half the proceeds of the sale of my Land lying in the State of Ohio, which said Land I have conditionally sold to James McKimley in the State of Kentucky, but in case the said sale should not be effectual, I then give to my said son Francis one half of the aforesaid Land to him and to his heirs forever.

Item I give and devise to my son Francis all the residue of my estate, be it of what nature or kind soever, to him and to his heirs forever.

Lastly - I will and direct that my sons Thomas Ridley and Francis Ridley - shall pay out of the estate, wills and devised to them each an equal Portion of all my Just debts, that is to say my son Thomas shall pay one half, and my son Francis shall pay the other half of my Just debts, and I do appoint my sons Thomas and Francis, Executors to this my last will and testament, and I further Direct, that my sons should not be compelled to give security for their executorial Proceeding and that estate be not appraised. Testimony of this writing being my Last will and Testament I here affix my seal and set my hand this third day of December 1809 Signed sealed, published and declared as and for the testament and Last will of Thomas Ridley Senr. in presence of
