Will—

In the name of god amen I Nancy Kirby of the County of Southern
often being of Perfect mind and memory, do make and be an
this my Last will and testament as follows to wit—

1st I give and bequeath unto Gideon I Bell all my right and
Interest in the negroes, which belongs to my son Turner Kirby
dec'd. which descended to me by the death of my said son.

as also the sum of three hundred and sixty dollars which
I am entitled to for board, schooling &c of said son Turner
Kirby for the space of six years, which said sum I desire
to be raised out of his estate and apply'd as above—

2nd I give to my daughter Eliza Hobbs wife of George
Hobbs one cow and calf to him and his heirs forever

3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Kirby all the
remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever as
also all my Interest in the balance of my said son Turner
Kirby's estate, to her and her heirs forever— But it is my
Will and desire that in Case my said daughter Sally
should die before she arrives to Lawful age, or without
Lawful Issue, then I give all the property intended for
her to Gideon I Bell, to him and his heirs forever—
And Lastly I do hereby appoint Gideon I Bell my
whole and sole executor of this my last will testament

Southampton the 28th day of March 1815 this will was

ing a probat thereof in due form wh^o gave bond & security to the Court
